
#### Atrial Arrhythmia in a 5-chambered heart!



#### Event ECG: Narrow QRS regular tachycardia




#### Post IV Amiodarone: Definite Atrial tachycardia

TTE: Exchange of blood between LA-LAA







### Trans-Esophageal echocardiogram

## Left Atrial Appendage Aneurysm: The 5<sup>th</sup> Chamber!

- ► LAAA, a congenital disorder. Overall, 89 case reports and 6 case series of LAAA were identified.
- May manifest as palpitations, shortness of breath, and cerebrovascular events. Often, incidentally diagnosed.
- Atrial fibrillation and atrial flutter are the most common associated arrhythmias.
- Surgical treatment is often recommended even in asymptomatic patients, as it can prevent the potential thromboembolic complications and treat associated atrial arrhythmias.
